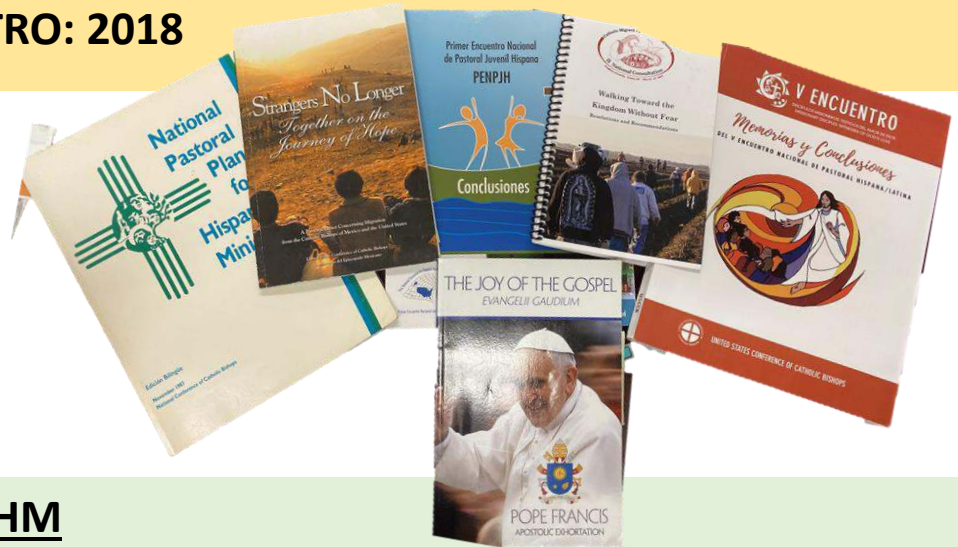

Missionary option: From Pews to Shoes

Joy of the Gospel: 20: All of us are asked to obey his call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the “peripheries” in need of the light of the Gospel.



- Hire a diocesan director of Migrant Ministry who can serve as a bridge between parishes and documented and Undocumented migrants and Immigrant Farmworkers.
- Create a diocesan team to supervise the formation of parish teams to accompany a farm workers.



- We ask that special attention be given to migrant and immigrant children and youth as they straddle two cultures.
- In many rural dioceses, the primary site of pastoral outreach for farm workers is the migrant camp, usually at a significant distance from the parish chu



Activities: a Pastoral action in farms and migrant camps by established Young adult groups: celebration of the eucharistic; evangelization and catechesis Coordinated at the parish or diocesan level Offer special sacramental preparation programs in the peripheries.



Disseminate practical information for migrant farm workers: mass times in Spanish legal service agencies and health clinics that facilitate access to their services
